

CHANGES ON THE MANHATTAN BUS ROUTES DUE TO MTA BUDGET CUTS

THESE CHANGES AFFECT ONLY THE MANHATTAN BUS RIDES SECTION OF THE GUIDE (pages 10 to 121)

M6 Southbound and Northbound tours Pages 48 to 71:

M6 service is discontinued and replaced by an extended M5 bus route.

For the discontinued M6 Southbound tour (pages 48 to 61), follow the M5 and M2 commentary as indicated to Broadway and E 8 St, then turn to page 56 and begin reading at SoHo to continue to the Staten Island Ferry.

The route of the discontinued M6 Southbound tour that is no longer covered (pages 49 to 56) can be taken as a walking tour.

The discontinued M6 Northbound tour (pages 62 to 71) is also replaced by the M5 bus.

M8 Eastbound and Westbound tours Pages 98 to 109:

M8 weekend and overnight service only has been discontinued.

M9 Northbound Tour Pages 111 to 121:

The M9 bus has been rerouted, but the old route can be followed as a walking tour.

M104 Eastbound Tour Pages 87 to 97:

M104 service east and west along 42 St is discontinued.

To continue the M104 Eastbound tour to the United Nations, take the M42 bus at W 42 St and Broadway to 1st Ave. Read from page 93 (Bryant Park) to page 96.

The remainder of the Manhattan Bus Rides are unaffected.
